

## Extended paper submission for FNL special issue on ICNF2025

1. Submitting an extended paper for the special issue of Fluctuation and Noise Letters is not mandatory. If your abstract was accepted, you can present your work in any case!
2. If you are willing to submit a paper for the FNL special issue, please note that your manuscript must comply with submission guidelines (<https://worldscientific.com/page/fnl/submission-guidelines>) especially in regards to the originality of content (section 4.e).
3. The manuscript must be prepared using the standard Fluctuation and noise Letters templates that can be downloaded from <https://worldscientific.com/page/fnl/submission-guidelines>

When your manuscript is ready, closely follow the procedure outlined below.

**Please note: the submission of the extended version is going to be managed as a brand new submission: you will not find any reference to the abstract you have already submitted in the new submission process. Of course, the managing editors will have access to the abstract you submitted for the conference.**

4. Go to the Fluctuations and Noise Letters main website (<https://worldscientific.com/worldscinet/fnl>) and click on “Submit an article”.





Check your file and, if everything is ok, click on “Approve Submission”.


